

# San Diego State University 2017 Homecoming Court Nomination Form *“Clash for the Can”*



*2016 SDSU Homecoming Court*

Homecoming at San Diego State University is an annual celebratory tradition. Students, faculty, staff, alumni, friends, and family gather to commemorate the outstanding achievements made by Aztecs. Through recognition of the Royal Court, San Diego State University honors those exceptional individuals who have shown their dedication through extraordinary commitment to leaving a legacy of pride.

Student organizations will submit nominations for the Royal Court by **4:00pm on Friday, September 8th.** All eligible Royal Court Nominees will complete a **Court Interview Application** in addition to the nomination. The Court Interview Application allows nominees to highlight their ideas for a service project and introduce themselves to the court interviewers. The Homecoming Court Application will be due on **September 18th**

## **THE ROYAL COURT**

Ten Royal Court members are chosen based on leadership, spirit, integrity, and achievement through their contributions and involvement at San Diego State University.

The Royal Court selection process begins with an application, which is completed by the individual being nominated and the nominating student organization. Based on application scores and cumulative grade point average, interviews are offered and conducted by SDSU faculty, staff, and alumni. The selection of the final two Royals is based on the evaluation of the applications and interviews.

The week prior to the Homecoming football game, the Royal Court members volunteer at an Aztec Unity Project and attend the time-honored annual Homecoming Brunch the day of the game. The announcement of the two Homecoming Royals takes place at the SDSU Homecoming football game on Saturday, October 21, 2017.

## **CANDIDATE REQUIREMENTS**

- Candidates can be nominated by **one** Recognized Student Organization, Associated Students Council, Honors Council, or fraternity, sorority or Greek auxiliary.
- **Two** candidate nominations are permitted per organization, chapter or council. (Please submit one application per nomination)
- Candidate must be an active, unpaid member of the nominating organization.
- Candidate must have completed at least 90 units by the time of nomination.
- Candidate must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5.
- Candidate must not be on academic or disciplinary probation. If the candidate is put on probation during the selection process, the candidate will be automatically disqualified.
- Only SDSU students who have **not** been selected to the court in prior years are eligible for candidacy to the 2017 SDSU Homecoming Court.

## **NOMINATION INSTRUCTIONS**

- The application must be typed in 12 point font, double spaced, with 1” margins and black Times New Roman font.
- Each section of the application must be clearly labeled with headings using the section headings below:
  - Section A: Nominee Information
  - Section B: Nominating Statement

### **Section A: Nominee Information**

- First Name, Middle Name, Last Name
- Email Address
- Major(s) and/or Minor(s)
- Nominating Recognized Student Organization/Council

### **Section B: Nominating Statement**

*Maximum: 1 page*

A statement must be included from an officer listed on the RSO (Recognized Student Organizations) application of the student organization/council that is nominating the candidate. The statement should outline:

- Nominating Officer's Name
- Contact Information
- Role in Organization
- Candidate's length of time in the organization/council
- Please list and describe (3) reasons why this candidate should be part of the Homecoming Court
- How this candidate exemplifies the values of San Diego State University
